### **President's Report:**

- Courageous Leaders are attempting to revamp the staff lounge to make it inviting for staff lounge.
  - o Currently unions and senates are the decision makers for these spaces.
    - Some pushback has occurred due to it perhaps not being done in the proper order.
  - Shannon is in this group and states that at this time, it is unclear who has the oversite of this project (district or unions/senate).
  - Debbie reiterated it should be taken to the union and the senates.
  - Some people are using it for events and not just as a staff lounge.
  - o Linda is disappointed that there is pushback and that it is misdirected.
    - Who advised Courageous Leaders on how to proceed to make changes?
  - Survey sent out from Jamie Cook.
    - Debbie will forward it out to everyone in Senate.
  - Previously, anyone that wants to use the room for non-break purposes, could not use it prior to 3 pm.
    - Kathy would like to see that come back to all groups to establish these rules.
  - Stephanie asks if this is somewhere in writing?
    - Debbie said that Sandy stated this is a negotiated item.



- O Not a new concept, but has fallen by the wayside.
  - For Classified Senate, just looking for a courtesy run by.
  - Sarah Hopkins was made aware of the ask at the graduation of the previous Courageous Leaders class.
- ISSC
  - o Dr. Garcia came to clarify where the DEIAAJ efforts are in the district.
    - Has followed-up with individuals in the ethnic studies department specifically, but is not going to share that in a public fashion.
    - Hoping to update the committee specifically.
- College Council
  - Going over survey results from the committees.
    - Results to every committee chair, asking all to respond to:
  - 1. Committee Roster
  - 2. When do they meet?
  - 3. What is their charge?
  - 4. Who do they make recommendations to?
- DEIAA workgroup will be created, not just constituent group (one will be by appointment per group), but people of expertise from different areas of the college will be appointed.
  - Meeting on Fridays (or every other Friday).
  - Taking place of PCC.
- SEIU is in the middle of negotiations.
  - o Encouraging SEIU to negotiate on Classified Senate's behalf for committee assignments.
  - The board recognized us 30 years ago as the shared governance piece of the college.
    - The committee assignments should belong to the shared governance piece and not the working conditions piece.
  - 9+1 put into the shared governance guide
    - o Purview should lie with Classified Senate

How do we want to move forward with appointing a Vice President?

- o Linda will be taking over at the summer retreat.
- o Appoint someone at that time as Vice President
  - o Email Executive Senate that you have an interest.
  - Will be an appointed position until elections happen for the following year.
- Kathy recommends:



- Sending a DL.Staff.Classified All
  - Debbie would like to have it be someone who has already served in the Senate already to take the position.
  - Maria would like to keep it in the group first
    - If no one, sent out to Classified All
  - We could not put Vice President on the ballot for 2024-2025 because the position was still filled.
  - Tina would like to open it up to DL.Classified.All or would like to reach out to the other individual who ran for president.
    - Debbie again reiterated that the individual will always need to be present at meetings.
  - Ann
    - Suggested adding a caveat stating exactly what the requirements would be for attendance for these positions.
  - The bylaws state the executive board can appoint between elections.
  - We will revisit in May.

#### **Elections**

- Number of ballots:
  - o 159 for both
- o Some people wrote-in the same names that they would have chosen not double counted
- Proposal that we have a video or written statement so people know who they are voting for and what they stand for in running for open positions.
- Foundation staff that are classified employees were not able to vote in this election, looking for clarity for next election.
  - Discussion if we want to include them going forward (two employees that are not considered district employees, but encourage them to work with us):
    - Not allowed to join the union as a foundation member, but are able to involved in the senate and could vote (Shannon).
    - Maria recalls Tina Laws being a senator and involved while working in the Senate



 Was a previous practice that we did include them - so we do not have to vote, as they were senators prior. Next year's election will include Foundation Staff.
